Rules:

2. Bands must submit a current roster of competing players with entry.
3. A representative from each band must be at the registration tent at 10:00 for the draw, designated tuning areas, and massed band instructions.
4. Bands must be ready when called to compete, or will be disqualified.
5. Decisions by the Director, Stewards and Judges are final.

Travel Assistance

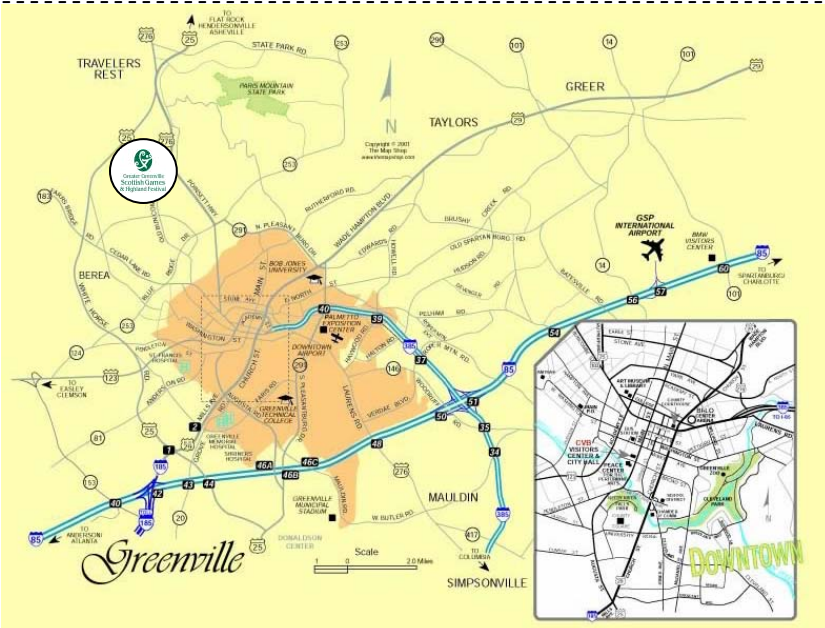
- The first 15 bands to register (as determined by postmark date) will be eligible for travel assistance based on one-way mileage to Furman University.
- Bands must appear in BOTH massed band performances on Saturday, May 29, to receive travel money. Separate grades of same band must appear separately, as well.
- Bands are eligible for compensation as follows: traveling 225 miles or less: \$350, 225 or more: \$500.

Friday Night's Kickoff Parade

- The City of Greenville and GGSGHF will host a kickoff parade through Downtown Greenville, ending in a Ceilidh in front of the Peace Center. Albannach will be performing – you won't want to miss it!
- Bands must be in Downtown Greenville at 5:00PM Friday. Details will follow for those registered. Only bands that march will receive compensation, if eligible.
- **1st 7 bands to register for the parade will receive \$500.**
